

First Millennium BCE • Epicenter—6th century BCE

(Imperial)

consciousness for future centuries.


# The Second Axial Age



Prophet Zoroaster(enters history in the 6th century BCE)


**Good-Evil Duality** 

Enormous influence on Judaism, Christianity, Islam, Buddhism, Greek philosophy, Baha'i (and western thought in general)

In the Second Axial Age, Zoroaster's teaching of the sacredness of earth, air, water, and fire grounds engaged ecological spirituality

### Baha'i Faith






### **Mutual Irradiation**
